# Book of Romans

## Romans Chapter Eight:

## Verse 33 --

"Who dares to lay charges against that which is God's possession, His own elect? God Himself justified them."

#### Verse 24 --

"What person is it that will condemn you? Christ is the one who bore your atrocities in His death, and then was raised up to a position of power at the right hand of God but uses that power and position to defend you by interceding on your behalf. If anyone has a right and the power to condemn you it is He, yet, He lives to Mercy Seat you."

## *Verse* 35 --

"Having experienced such things from Him, who then can keep us also from living by the same sacrificial love that Christ displayed toward us? Shall the experiences of tribulation, distress, persecutions, famine, nakedness, peril, or sword discourage us from His crucified way?

#### Verse 36 --

The Bible is clear on this: 'For the sake of being with You in this way of the Cross we are continually put to death in daily affairs of life; we are presented to the altar as sacrificial lambs'.

#### *Verse 37 --*

"But really, in all these things we find fertile ground for demonstrating a new kind of power that was made known by Him and shown to us by His kind of love displayed at Calvary."

#### Verse 38 --

I am completely convinced that the contrasts of life that trip most people up such as death contrasted with life, angels contrasted with principalities and powers, things that are present contrasted with what will come,

## *Verse 39 --*

things high or things low, nor any other situation that can be created shall be able to supersede and therefore void out the possibility of the demonstration of the crucified love of God that is in Christ Jesus
